

## **BOARDRIDING CLUB - Risk Management Policy**

Our risk management policy is to adopt the best practice in risk management, we agree to implement and ensure that risk management is an integral and structured part of all planning and decisions concerning our board riding club, club events and all club activities.

The Mullaloo Longboarders Club will implement a structured risk management plan to minimise any possible and foreseeable damage, interruption to operations, danger or harm to persons, damage to the environment, landscape and or property. We will agree to identify and take advantage of all opportunities available to our organisation, in addition.

### **Process**

A risk management procedure has been established, based on the Australian Standard AS/NZS 4360:1999. It should be used for guidance by everyone involved with the application of risk management.

The Management Committee will facilitate the development of common risk management approach across all areas of our club business –

1. Implementing the adopted risk management program
2. Sharing information with broad applicability across all areas; and
3. Reporting on the progress of implementing the risk management program.

### **Monitoring & Review**

The club agrees to monitor and review the implementation of the risk management program.

### **Responsibilities**

The Mullaloo Longboarders Club Committee is to be accountable for the implementation of the risk management process within the club and is accountable for the management of all risks concerning the club operations.

All Mullaloo Lonboarders Club committee personnel are responsible for managing risks within their respective areas during events, general club activities, and all club members have responsibility to ensure that risks within their control are managed in the interests of the organization, safety of Mullaloo Longboarders Club events, and managing all risks that may occur in the nature of the organization's business and operations.
